The Growth allocation is designed to generate capital appreciation.

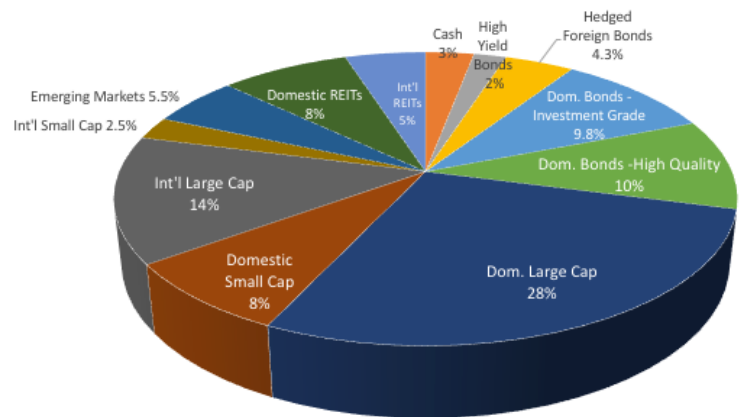
Philosophy

The Growth allocation is invested approximately 70% in stocks and 30% in bonds and cash. Both the stock and bond allocations are broadly diversified across different asset classes and managers. The diversification is designed to lower the expected volatility of the portfolios' returns and help protect against negative market environments.

The U.S. and international stock allocations have a value orientation to potentially reduce portfolio volatility and downside risk.

Implementation

TIAA Kaspic implements the allocation using an array of carefully screened, low-cost mutual funds. The portfolio is maintained in a custody account at Charles Schwab & Co., Inc., and is rebalanced periodically.
