### **2021 Stewardship Theme Ideas**

**Stewardship- A Four Part Harmony:** This four-week series looks at different aspects of how we live as stewards: our care of self, care of one another, care of stuff, and care of creation. Utilizing a different scripture passage for each week, the series focuses on conversation, reflection, and identifying ways in which people will grow in their care of the four areas.

**Every Perfect Gift** resource from the Episcopal Network for Stewardship (TENS): Centered on James 1:17, the package includes a campaign calendar, sample commitment cards, prayers, and more. It is available in both English and Spanish. MMFA can share specifics about the package with you.

**In All Things, Love:** Based on 1 John 4:7, this theme focuses on stewardship as an expression of gospel love in the world. Invite people to share how they have received love (from God, from the community) and how they share it through gifts of time, talent, treasure, and testimony. Utilize a simple heart design and ask people to write down one thing they love about their church. Then post all those hearts on one wall where people can see them, as well as incorporate them into online worship/the church website through a video or photo album.

**6 Words to Build On and Live By** by the Rev. Gary Marsh: This six-week series incorporates scripture, theme statements and development, and a commitment card to help congregations explore six aspects of discipleship: Live, Gather, Connect, Serve, Give, Multiply.
